41	Luke	22:19	And He took bread, gave thanks and broke it, and gave it to them,

44	John	1:29	The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, "Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world

53	John	14:6	Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.
54	Romans	3:21	But now the righteousness of God apart from the law is revealed, being witnessed by the Law and the Prophets,
55	Romans	3:22	even the righteousness of God, through faith in Jesus Christ, to all and on all who believe. For there is no difference;
56	Romans	3:23	for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,
57	Romans	3:24	being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus,
58	Romans	3:25	whom God set forth as a propitiation by His blood, through faith, to demonstrate His righteousness, because in His forbearance God had passed over the sins that were previously committed,
59	Romans	3:26	to demonstrate at the present time His righteousness, that He might be just



			and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus.
60	Romans	5:1	Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ,
61	Romans	5:2	through whom also we have access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.
62	Romans	5:6	For when we were still without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly.
63	Romans	5:7	For scarcely for a righteous man will one die; yet perhaps for a good man someone would even dare to die.
64	Romans	5:8	But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.
65	Romans	5:9	Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him.
66	Romans	5:10	For if when we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life.
67	Romans	5:11	And not only that, but we also rejoice in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received the reconciliation.
68	Romans	5:18	Therefore, as through one man's offense judgment came to all men, resulting in condemnation, even so through one Man's righteous act the free gift came to all men, resulting in justification of life.
69	Romans	5:19	For as by one man's disobedience many were made sinners, so also by one Man's obedience many will be made righteous.
70	Romans	8:1	There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit.
71	Romans	8:2	For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death.
72	Romans	8:3	For what the law could not do in that it was weak through the flesh, God did by sending His own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, on account of sin: He condemned sin in the flesh,
73	Romans	8:29	For whom He foreknew, He also predestined to be conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren.
74	Romans	8:30	Moreover whom He predestined, these He also called; whom He called, these He also justified; and whom He justified, these He also glorified.
75	Romans	8:38	For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come,
76	Romans	8:39	nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate



			us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
77	Romans	9:14	What shall we say then? Is there unrighteousness with God? Certainly not!
78	Romans	9:15	For He says to Moses, "I will have mercy on whomever I will have mercy, and I will have compassion on whomever I will have compassion."
79	Romans	9:16	So then it is not of him who wills, nor of him who runs, but of God who shows mercy.
80	Romans	11:33	Oh, the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are His judgments and His ways past finding out!
81	1 Corinthians	1:26	For you see your calling, brethren, that not many wise according to the flesh, not many mighty, not many noble, are called.
82	1 Corinthians	1:27	But God has chosen the foolish things of the world to put to shame the wise, and God has chosen the weak things of the world to put to shame the things which are mighty;
83	1 Corinthians	1:28	and the base things of the world and the things which are despised God has chosen, and the things which are not, to bring to nothing the things that are,
84	1 Corinthians	1:29	that no flesh should glory in His presence.
85	1 Corinthians	1:30	But of Him you are in Christ Jesus, who became for us wisdom from God—and righteousness and sanctification and redemption
86	1 Corinthians	6:19	Or do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and you are not your own?
87	1 Corinthians	6:20	For you were bought at a price; therefore glorify God in your body and in your spirit, which are God's.
88	1 Corinthians	11:23	For I received from the Lord that which I also delivered to you: that the Lord Jesus on the same night in which He was betrayed took bread;
89	1 Corinthians	11:24	and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, "Take, eat; this is My body which is broken for you; do this in remembrance of Me."
90	1 Corinthians	11:25	In the same manner He also took the cup after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in My blood. This do, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me."
91	1 Corinthians	11:26	For as often as you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death till He comes.
92	1 Corinthians	11:27	Therefore whoever eats this bread or drinks this cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty of the body and blood of the Lord.
93	1 Corinthians	11:28	But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of the bread and drink of the cup.

94	1 Corinthians	11:29	For he who eats and drinks in an unworthy manner eats and drinks judgment to himself, not discerning the Lord's body.
95	1 Corinthians	11:30	For this reason many are weak and sick among you, and many sleep.
96	1 Corinthians	12:13	For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free and have all been made to drink into one Spirit.
97	1 Corinthians	15:20	But now Christ is risen from the dead, and has become the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep.
98	1 Corinthians	15:21	For since by man came death, by Man also came the resurrection of the dead.
99	1 Corinthians	15:22	For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ all shall be made alive.
100	1 Corinthians	15:23	But each one in his own order: Christ the firstfruits, afterward those who are Christ's at His coming.
101	2 Corinthians	5:21	For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.
102	2 Corinthians	8:9	For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though He was rich, yet for your sakes He became poor, that you through His poverty might become rich.
103	Galatians	1:3	Grace to you and peace from God the Father and our Lord Jesus Christ,
104	Galatians	1:4	who gave Himself for our sins, that He might deliver us from this present evil age, according to the will of our God and Father,
105	Galatians	1:5	to whom be glory forever and ever. Amen.
106	Galatians	3:13	Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree"),
107	Galatians	3:14	that the blessing of Abraham might come upon the Gentiles in Christ Jesus, that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.
108	Ephesians	1:3	Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ,
109	Ephesians	1:4	just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love,
110	Ephesians	1:5	having predestined us to adoption as sons by Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will,
111	Ephesians	1:6	to the praise of the glory of His grace, by which He made us accepted in the Beloved.
112	Ephesians	1:7	In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace
113	Ephesians	1:8	which He made to abound toward us in all wisdom and prudence,



114	Ephesians	1:9	having made known to us the mystery of His will, according to His good pleasure which He purposed in Himself,
115	Ephesians	1:10	that in the dispensation of the fullness of the times He might gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven and which are on earth in Him.
116	Ephesians	1:11	In Him also we have obtained an inheritance, being predestined according to the purpose of Him who works all things according to the counsel of His will,
117	Ephesians	1:12	that we who first trusted in Christ should be to the praise of His glory.
118	Ephesians	2:1	And you He made alive, who were dead in trespasses and sins,
119	Ephesians	2:2	in which you once walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit who now works in the sons of disobedience,
120	Ephesians	2:3	among whom also we all once conducted ourselves in the lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, just as the others.
121	Ephesians	2:4	But God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us,
122	Ephesians	2:5	even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved),
123	Ephesians	2:6	and raised us up together, and made us sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus,
124	Ephesians	2:7	that in the ages to come He might show the exceeding riches of His grace in His kindness toward us in Christ Jesus.
125	Ephesians	2:8	For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God,
126	Ephesians	2:9	not of works, lest anyone should boast.
127	Ephesians	2:14	For He Himself is our peace, who has made both one, and has broken down the middle wall of separation,
128	Ephesians	2:15	having abolished in His flesh the enmity, that is, the law of commandments contained in ordinances, so as to create in Himself one new man from the two, thus making peace,
129	Ephesians	2:16	and that He might reconcile them both to God in one body through the cross, thereby putting to death the enmity.
130	Ephesians	5:2	And walk in love, as Christ also has loved us and given Himself for us, an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweet-smelling aroma.
131	Philippians	2:5	Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus,
132	Philippians	2:6	who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God,



133	Philippians	2:7	but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men.
134	Philippians	2:8	And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross.
135	Philippians	2:9	Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name,
136	Philippians	2:10	that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth,
137	Philippians	2:11	and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
138	Colossians	1:12	giving thanks to the Father who has qualified us to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in the light.
139	Colossians	1:13	He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed us into the kingdom of the Son of His love,
140	Colossians	1:14	in whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins.
141	Colossians	1:15	He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation.
142	Colossians	1:16	For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him.
143	Colossians	1:17	And He is before all things, and in Him all things consist.
144	Colossians	1:18	And He is the head of the body, the church, who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in all things He may have the preeminence.
145	Colossians	1:19	For it pleased the Father that in Him all the fullness should dwell,
146	Colossians	1:20	and by Him to reconcile all things to Himself, by Him, whether things on earth or things in heaven, having made peace through the blood of His cross
147	Colossians	1:21	And you, who once were alienated and enemies in your mind by wicked works, yet now He has reconciled
148	Colossians	1:22	in the body of His flesh through death, to present you holy, and blameless, and above reproach in His sight
149	Colossians	2:3	in whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge.
150	Colossians	2:9	For in Him dwells all the fullness of the Godhead bodily;
151	Colossians	2:13	And you, being dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He has made alive together with Him, having forgiven you all trespasses,
152	Colossians	2:14	having wiped out the handwriting of requirements that was against us, which was contrary to us. And He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross.



153	1 Timothy	2:5	For there is one God and one Mediator between God and men, the Man Christ Jesus,
154	1 Timothy	2:6	who gave Himself a ransom for all, to be testified in due time,
155	Titus	2:11	For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men,
156	Titus	2:12	teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live
157	Titus	2:13	soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age, looking for the blessed hope and glorious appearing of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ,
158	Titus	2:14	who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from every lawless deed and purify for Himself His own special people, zealous for good works.
159	Titus	3:4	But when the kindness and the love of God our Savior toward man appeared,
160	Titus	3:5	not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy He saved us, through the washing of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Spirit,
161	Titus	3:6	whom He poured out on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Savior,
162	Titus	3:7	that having been justified by His grace we should become heirs according to the hope of eternal life.
163	Hebrews	1:1	God, who at various times and in various ways spoke in time past to the fathers by the prophets,
164	Hebrews	1:2	has in these last days spoken to us by His Son, whom He has appointed heir of all things, through whom also He made the worlds;
165	Hebrews	1:3	who being the brightness of His glory and the express image of His person, and upholding all things by the word of His power, when He had by Himself purged our sins, sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high
166	Hebrews	2:9	But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels, for the suffering of death crowned with glory and honor, that He, by the grace of God, might taste death for everyone.
167	Hebrews	2:10	For it was fitting for Him, for whom are all things and by whom are all things, in bringing many sons to glory, to make the captain of their salvation perfect through sufferings.
168	Hebrews	2:11	For both He who sanctifies and those who are being sanctified are all of one, for which reason He is not ashamed to call them brethren,
169	Hebrews	2:14	Inasmuch then as the children have partaken of flesh and blood, He Himself likewise shared in the same, that through death He might destroy him who had the power of death, that is, the devil,
170	Hebrews	2:15	and release those who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage.
171	Hebrews	5:8	though He was a Son, yet He learned obedience by the things which He suffered.
172	Hebrews	5:9	And having been perfected, He became the author of eternal salvation to all



			who obey Him,
173	Hebrews	5:10	called by God as High Priest "according to the order of Melchizedek,"
174	Hebrews	7:25	Therefore He is also able to save to the uttermost those who come to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them.
175	Hebrews	7:26	For such a High Priest was fitting for us, who is holy, harmless, undefiled, separate from sinners, and has become higher than the heavens;
176	Hebrews	9:13	For if the blood of bulls and goats and the ashes of a heifer, sprinkling the unclean, sanctifies for the purifying of the flesh,
177	Hebrews	9:14	how much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without spot to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?
178	Hebrews	10:3	But in those sacrifices there is a reminder of sins every year.
179	Hebrews	10:4	For it is not possible that the blood of bulls and goats could take away sins.
180	Hebrews	10:14	For by one offering He has perfected forever those who are being sanctified.
181	1 Peter	2:4	Coming to Him as to a living stone, rejected indeed by men, but chosen by God and precious,
182	1 Peter	2:5	you also, as living stones, are being built up a spiritual house, a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ.
183	1 Peter	2:9	But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light;
184	1 Peter	2:10	who once were not a people but are now the people of God, who had not obtained mercy but now have obtained mercy.
185	1 Peter	2:22	"Who committed no sin, Nor was deceit found in His mouth";
186	1 Peter	2:23	who, when He was reviled, did not revile in return; when He suffered, He did not threaten, but committed Himself to Him who judges righteously;
187	1 Peter	2:24	who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness by whose stripes you were healed.
188	1 Peter	2:25	For you were like sheep going astray, but have now returned to the Shepherd and Overseer of your souls.
189	1 Peter	3:18	For Christ also suffered once for sins, the just for the unjust, that He might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh but made alive by the Spirit,
190	1 John	3:1	Behold what manner of love the Father has bestowed on us, that we should be called children of God! Therefore the world does not know us, because i did not know Him.



191	1 John	3:2	Beloved, now we are children of God; and it has not yet been revealed what we shall be, but we know that when He is revealed, we shall be like Him, for we shall see Him as He is.
192	Jude	1:24	Now to Him who is able to keep you from stumbling, And to present you faultless Before the presence of His glory with exceeding joy,
193	Jude	1:25	To God our Savior Who alone is wise, Be glory and majesty, Dominion and power, Both now and forever. Amen.
194	Revelation	4:8	The four living creatures, each having six wings, were full of eyes around and within. And they do not rest day or night, saying: "Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, Who was and is and is to come!"
195	Revelation	4:11	"You are worthy, O Lord, To receive glory and honor and power; For You created all things, And by Your will they exist and were created."
196	Revelation	5:9	And they sang a new song, saying: "You are worthy to take the scroll, And to open its seals; For You were slain, And have redeemed us to God by Your blood Out of every tribe and tongue and people and nation,
197	Revelation	5:10	And have made us kings and priests to our God; And we shall reign on the earth."
198	Revelation	5:11	Then I looked, and I heard the voice of many angels around the throne, the living creatures, and the elders; and the number of them was ten thousand times ten thousand, and thousands of thousands,
199	Revelation	5:12	saying with a loud voice: "Worthy is the Lamb who was slain To receive power and riches and wisdom, And strength and honor and glory and blessing!"
